



LATE TITLE RETURN POLICY

A seller has up to a maximum of 30 calendar days to deliver a title to the auction (sale day is day 1).

On the 30th day, the buyer may notify the auction in writing of their intention to return the vehicle. The seller then has until the close of business on the following business day (excluding holidays) to deliver the title to the auction. If the title is not received by the auction at close of business on the following day, buyer may return the vehicle in like condition with less than 500 additional miles from date of purchase and must again notify the title department that the vehicle is being returned for late title. Buyer will be reimbursed for return transportation with verifiable receipt. Seller will be charged the amount of the return transportation. Buyers in the metropolitan area must return the vehicle by close of business, out of town buyers must return the vehicle within 3 days.

If the title is 180 days old or more, buyer may return vehicle and be reimbursed for all verifiable expenses.

If seller requests a vehicle back for any reason, buyer will be reimbursed for all verifiable expenses.
